The Department of Computer Science at Queens College of the City University of New York (CUNY) is accepting applications for a tenure track position in modeling and simulation at the Assistant Professor level for Fall 2012.

Queens College of CUNY, located on a 76-acre campus, is an urban liberal arts college that emphasizes both research and teaching. The department, with two current NSF CAREER Award winners on its faculty, serves approximately 500 undergraduate majors and 100 master's degree students. It also participates actively in the Ph.D. program based at the CUNY Graduate Center. Responsibilities include teaching undergraduate and master's level courses, and establishing a record of research and scholarship as evidenced by peer reviewed publications, conference presentations, grant applications, and funded research. The successful candidate will play a key role in our planned Computational Infrastructure for the Sciences Center and collaborate with researchers both within and without the CS department on large-scale interdisciplinary applications.
