CS 398 - Internship Application Form

Students interested in applying for an internship must have completed 15 credits in computer science. Students may not take a total of more than six credits of internships, and CS 398 may not be applied to the computer science major or minor.

An internship is a credit-bearing, non-salaried placement in a company where the student works on a specific project for a fixed time with the approval of a faculty member and a company supervisor. The placement may include a stipend for travel, meals, etc. The student will receive a grade based on: (1) Mid-term and final reports submitted by the student, (2) An end-term evaluation from the supervisor, and (3) faculty evaluation of the project.

Information about available internships may be found at the College Office of Career Development and Internships in Frese Hall.

Application Procedure:

Completely fill out parts A, B and C of this application, and give it to the department secretary. It will be reviewed by the department's Internship Committee, and if approved you will be allowed to register for CS 398. You should allow at least two weeks for the entire process.
